Named after the protected and most important bird species in the park, The Peregrine plays homage to the natural surroundings. The choice of the colour palette throughout the restaurant was similarly influenced by the local nature with an array of forest green textiles used throughout, with burnt mahogany accent

shades. Bespoke murals were hand painted to capture the flora and fauna of the park.
